

Visiting the Valley Gardens in Windsor Great Park



The Valley Gardens cover some 250 acres of beautiful woodland garden on the north shore of Virginia Water lake. The gardens are famous for their National Collections of trees and shrubs. Although spectacular in springtime, the Valley Gardens are full of interest all the year round.

Access to The Valley Gardens

The Valley Gardens are free for pedestrians to explore 365 days a year, from 8am until dusk. Within the gardens, including the northern shoreline of the lake, cycles are not permitted and all dogs must be kept on leads.

If you are ...	We recommend ...
... visiting for the first time	Come to The Savill Building (postcode TW20 0UU – see map below). Our reception staff will show you how best to reach the Valley Gardens. Soon you will also be able to buy a special guide pack full of topical information to help you enjoy your visit.
... a 'Car Park' pass holder	You may park for free at The Savill Garden, Virginia Water and Blacknest car parks – each is about 20 mins walk to The Valley Gardens. (See next panel for information about The Valley Gardens Car Park.)
... not able to walk very far	There is car entrance in Wick Road – about ¼ mile from the junction with the A30. Admission is free for 'Car Park' pass holders – otherwise you will need up to £6 in coins (the price varies by season) to pay for vehicle admission and open the automatic barrier. You may then drive (slowly please!) through the Park to reach a Car Park on the northern edge of the Valley Gardens
... a group arriving by coach or minibus	Telephone in advance (01784 435544) to arrange your visit. Coaches and minibuses should arrive first at The Savill Building (postcode TW20 0UU) and use the refreshment / toilet facilities there. A park Warden will then escort your vehicle through the Park to the edge of the Valley Gardens. There is a £60 fee for this, payable at The Savill Building.

Refreshments

The award winning Savill Building offers a great selection of snacks, picnic items and full restaurant meals. It is open from 10am, 7 days a week. It closes at 4.30pm in the Winter (October-February) and 6pm at other times of the year.

Toilets

Facilities, including for the disabled, are available at The Savill Building, within the Valley Gardens, and at the Wheatsheaf pub in Virginia Water.
