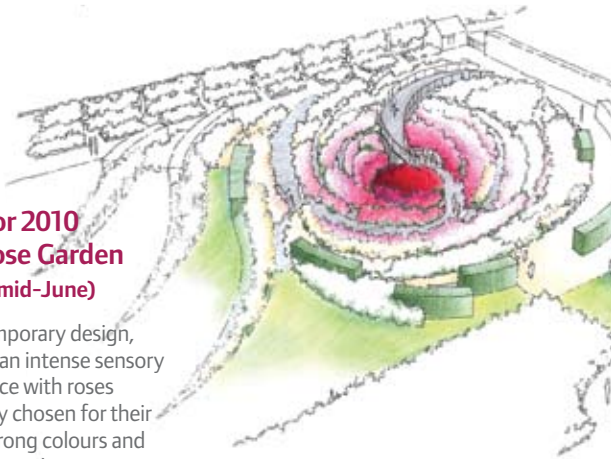

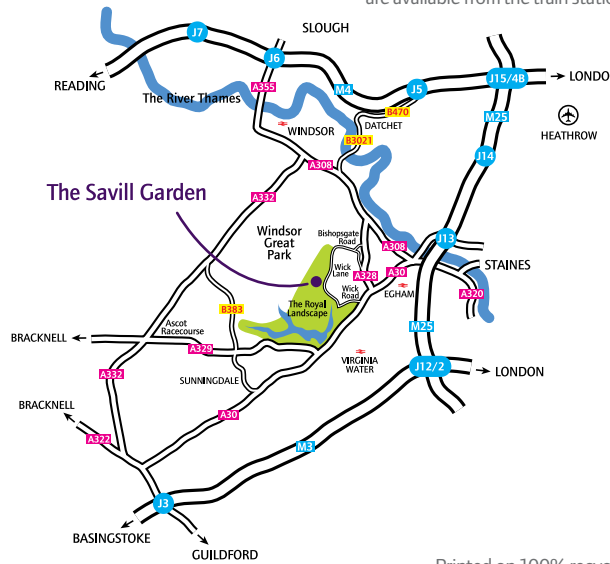

- Located off A30, M25 junction 13 or M4 junction 6.
- 15 minutes drive from Windsor town centre. Follow the brown tourist road signs.

- Egham and Virginia Water stations are on the direct line into Waterloo. Taxis are available from the train stations.

The Savill Garden was created by Sir Eric Savill, grand master of the woodland garden, in the 1930s with the support of King George V and Queen Mary.

Since that time, the Garden has continued to develop under royal patronage, and visitors have enjoyed the opportunity to explore this magnificent royal garden.
